- Collaboration between City & County of Honolulu, DOH, and H3RC
  - City is leaseholder
  - AMHD service contractor
  - H3RC is contracted provider

# Call CARES Crisis Line 832-3100

## Appropriate Referrals

- Short term (3-14 day) stays for behavioral health stabilization
- Clients in mental health and/or substance use crisis that need to be stabilized, but are not inpatient level of care
- Clients that are decompensating and are in need of mental health and/or substance use stabilization
  - Can take those with unknown or positive COVID status as well
- For this site must be homeless or at risk for homelessness

## Stabilization Beds

**We provide:**

- Behavioral health support
- Connection to benefits
  - SNAP, MedQuest
- **Telehealth**
- **Accompany to appt.**
- **Support and care coordination**

**Not appropriate:**

- No active SI/HI
- Those that need med management
  - We cannot dispense meds but can do directly observed therapy
- Those who cannot climb stairs or do ADLs
