# Where do you fall in the distribution plan?

- Phase 1a: Healthcare personnel and long-term care facility residents ~ 6% of population
- Phase 1b: Frontline essential workers and adults 75 years of age and older ~20% of population
- Phase 1c: Adults age 65 to 74 years, persons 16 to 64 years with high-risk medical conditions, and essential workers not included in Phase 1b, ~47% of population.

### in the Vaccine Timeline?

 Healthcare personnel Long-term care facility residents

- First responders
- Frontline essential workers
- Adults 75 years of age and older

### Spring 2021

- Adults age 65 to 74 years
- Persons 16 to 64 years with high-risk medical conditions
- Essential workers not included in the previous group



### Summer 2021
