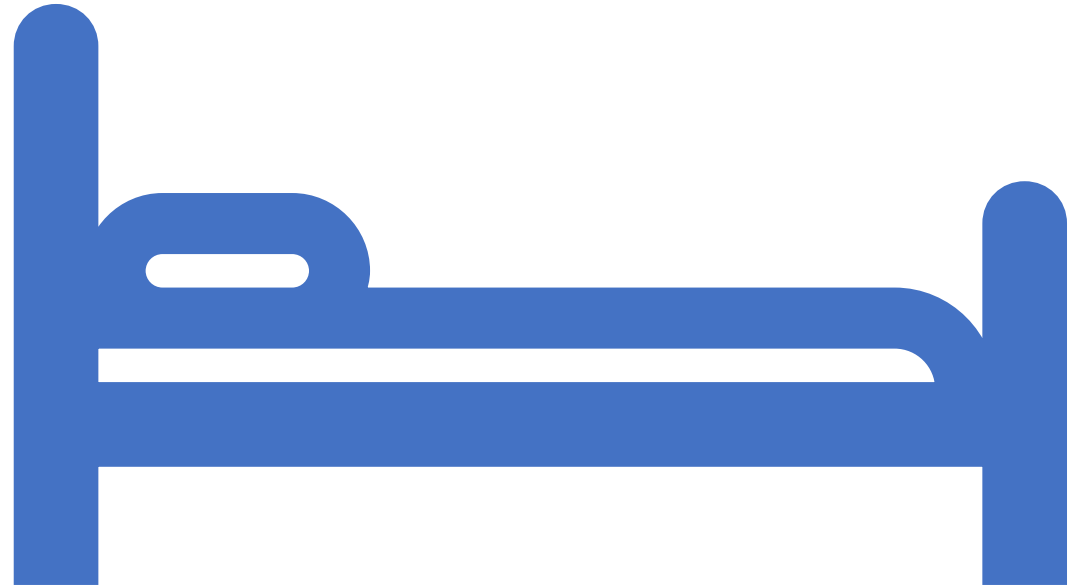


Bed Stabilization Updates

Hawai'i CARES DOH bed stabilization protocol

- **Purpose/appropriate client:**
- Client in mental health crisis and needs to be triaged and stabilized.
- Recent substance use and need a place for stabilization as bridge to substance use disorder treatment and recovery services.
- Homeless with mental health concerns, needs connection to case management for connection to behavioral health and AMHD housing services.
- Discharged from correctional facility, seeking wrap around behavioral health services
- Discharged from inpatient care and the client has behavioral health concerns (mental health condition and/or substance use disorder (SUD)), seeking connection to mental health or SUD services.

Hawai'i CARES DOH bed stabilization protocol

- **Not appropriate for placement:**
- Being discharged from another stabilization facility (e.g. LCRS) for purposes of housing.
- An individual who is requiring medical detox services (alcohol or heroine w/d)
- An individual requiring hands on assistance with performing activities of daily living (ADLs)
- Requires an assistive device for ambulation.
- Children under age 18
- Co-occurring complex medical conditions that require CPAP or supplemental oxygen or other continuous monitoring (includes incontinency)
- Involuntary admission
- Active suicidal ideations
- Smokers who are unwilling to use nicotine gum or patches
