<i>Kahauiki Village</i>	<p>I have a family who put in an application back in November 2021, and they were told because there is a new property management they will have to fill out a new application. We are having a hard time getting in touch with someone to assist in completing the new application.</p> <p>Also, how do families submit applications for Kahauiki Village?</p>	<p>I.H.S. will be sending out the new application for Kahauiki Village very shortly. <i>Kahauiki Village</i>	<p>Are there any income or financial requirements?</p>	<p>These requirements are currently being updated as the property management transitions to a new provider. In general, we look at whether the household income is sufficient to cover the monthly rent for a unit, knowing that the rent is \$775 per month for a one-bedroom unit and \$950 per month for a two-bedroom unit. Also, please understand that the units are not limited only to families with minor children or for seniors.</p>
<i>Kahauiki Village</i>	<p>If I have a client who is a houseless single mother struggling to get a job because there is no one to watch her child, could she apply for Kahauiki Village?</p>	<p>Yes, the client can apply. However, she would need a steady source of income. Kahauiki Village does have some tenants who are single mothers, however they are employed. Please contact I.H.S. staff and we can discuss some employment options for this individual.</p>
