<i>Hawaii Island Medical Respite</i>	Are there medical respite programs on the other islands?	<p>Ka Hale A Ke Ola on Maui also provides medical respite beds in partnership with Maui Memorial Hospital.</p> <p>On Oahu, the Institute for Human Services, Kalihi-Palama Health Center, and the H4 program operate similar short-term medical respite facilities in partnership with Oahu acute care facilities, such as Queen’s Medical Center.</p>
<i>Honolulu CORE Update</i>	Based on the information provided, are substance use professionals involved in the CORE program?	<p>Currently, CORE does not directly employ substance use professionals. However, they do partner with other provider organizations offering these services, and make referrals for substance use treatment through the Hawaii CARES line (808-832-3100).</p> <p>CORE is also looking at contracting with substance use treatment facilities to reserve a small number of beds for referrals from the program.</p>
